Science and Social Studies

This week, we continued our Becoming America unit. We learned about explorers, colonists, the 1700's and the 1800's. On Friday, students used Pebble Go and Google Slides to research and share information about a famous Native American leader. Next week, we will begin to learn about different winter holidays. We will focus on Diwali and Hannukah next week. We will also read one of my favorite books, <u>The</u> Chanukkah Guest.

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Language Arts

This week, our spelling list focused on final blends and verbs. Next week's list will focus on the two sounds of y and adjectives. In writing, we are learning about responding to reading. We made an anchor chart for RACE (restate, answer, cite and explain). We also practiced responding to a question by restating and answering. We also practiced using RACE to respond to questions about Fables. In reading, we started to learn about Fables. Fables are usually a short story about animals that teach us a lesson. In reading groups, we are continuing to make great progress. I am meeting with virtual learners during DEAR time so they do not have to log back on at the end of the day. If your child is all virtual, please feel free to "assign" DEAR during a time convenient for you.

Math

This week, students completed the Topic 1-4 benchmark. I am pleased with their progress and we will continue to practice these concepts throughout the school year. We also started to learn about subtracting two-digit numbers with and without regrouping. We spent two days practicing with Unifex cubes. On Friday, we completed Topic 6:1. We will continue Topic 6 next week. Please continue to practice subtraction facts at home! ReFlex math is a great way to practice!
