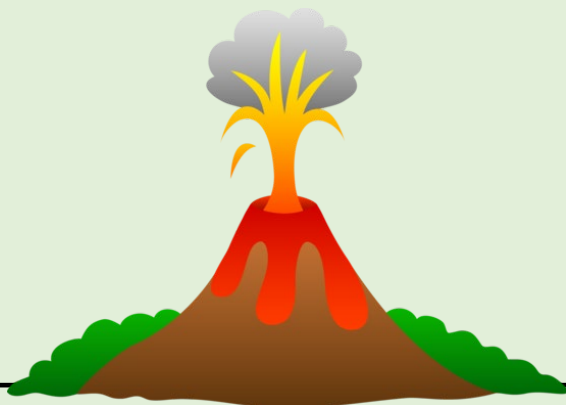
Class News!

Science and Social Studies

We continued to learn about landforms this week. Students self selected a landform to research. They used their research to create a slideshow with images. We shared our presentations with the class.
