Science and Social Studies

Our SEL lesson this week was about Self-Talk. We can use self-talk to help us ignore distractions and stay focused while learning. This is a very important skill, even as an adult! We love listening to the song, "Be a Learner". We also continued our family ties unit. We learned about where we live and the different types of communities. Students worked on individual posters for urban, suburban and rural communities. I will display these on our hallway bulletin board.

This week, we learned about short o and short u. Next week, our spelling list will focus on short e. We will also review all short vowel sounds. In writing, we worked on our middle and endings. We also talked about transition words. Next week, we will edit and publish a story. In reading, we learned about fluency. Fluency is when you read like you are talking. Not too slow and not too fast. We practiced reading and stopping at the punctuation. We also took our Reading Inventory assessment. Scores will be share with parents soon. I have also started running record assessments.

Math

This week, we started Topic 1:1-Fluently Add and Subtract Within 20. We learned about related facts, doubles and doubles plus 1, making 10 to add, addition fact patters and counting on and back to subtract.
