
There are a bunch of rules in soccer. If you get two yellow cards you cannot be in the next game. You can get a yellow card by sliding and tackling an opponent. If you get a red card you can't play in the game. If you handball the soccer ball in the eighteen yard box the other team takes a penalty kick from inside the box in the exact middle. It is rare for it to be saved by a goalie but if they do save it then the other team can come inside the box and try to kick it away from the goal and try to score on the other half of the field.

There is a lot of equipment in soccer. In soccer there is one ball and usually four referees. Each player has shin guards, a jersey for their team, and cleats. There are also two big goals.

You can play soccer by just playing with your friend in the backyard or you could be playing in a stadium and on TV. The reason I got into soccer is because my dad used to be on a soccer team. My dad taught soccer to me, so I am now really good at playing it. I am on a travel soccer team. I encourage you to play soccer even if you are bad


