# DIGITAL MEDIA & YEARBOOK CLUB CREW Code of Conduct

#### **Club Objectives**

To share the different events, activities and people of BRMS in an appropriate, responsible, professional manner.

#### Eligibility & Expectations of Crew Members

Students 6-8th are all welcome. Students will be expected to carry around a camera throughout the day, pictures and create twitter posts. Students will be asked to complete assignments that are discussed at the general meeting. Each member is responsible for an assigned camera throughout the day.

#### Club Rules

Students are expected to observe the following Rules:

- 1. Follow all BRMS rules.
- 2. Do not share any photos on any social media. All pictures are for BRMS Use Only. Not for personal use!
- 3. Be an active participant, attend meetings & keep in contact with advisors.
- 4. Represent the whole school: students & staff (means not just taking photos of just your friends)
- 5. Act in a respectful, a responsible, and a professional manner at all times.
- 6. Be responsibility of the camera, keep it safe & return it in working condition at the end of the day
- 7. Do not allow anyone else to use the camera. No inappropriate photos
- 8. Taking pictures should interrupt the crew members learning or the learning of others.
- 9. Sign the camera out and back in when complete with the assignment.
- 10. Capture only photos assigned by Mrs. Smith or Mrs. Mullen

### Consequences:

Students who do not meet behavioral expectations will not be allowed to participate in taking a pictures.

<u>General Meetings</u>: Each member should try to attend at least one meeting per month. Assignments will be given out and pictures will be reviewed during these times.

## **Equipment**

Each student is responsible for taking care of the cameras when they are in their possession.
