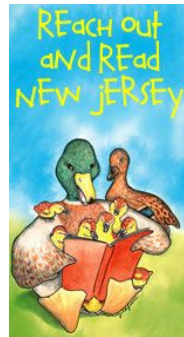


# The "Helping Hands" Club at Bragg Elementary School is having a "Children's Book

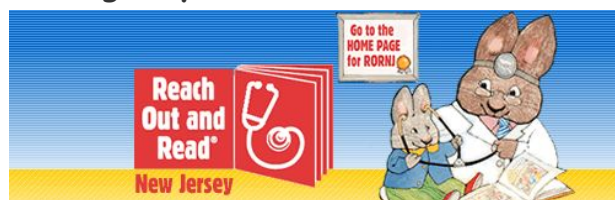
